Chronic Absenteeism is defined as missing 18 days in a school year



Most Research Emphasizes the Impact of Chronically Absent Students



Less likely to read at grade level by the end of 3rd grade

4X more likely to drop out of high school than their peers





Perform lower on reading and math achievement than their peers

Less likely to be enrolled in a Gifted & Talented Program





20 to 40% of those chronically absent need additional supplemental or intensive academic or behavioral support

When a student misses just 4 days a month, they miss 40 days a school year. By graduation, they've missed 2 years of school.
